<p>MCAC Football Coaches Meeting Minutes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Voted to accept the proposal for the 2020 Schedule submitted by Central Lakes College.</li> <li>• Voted to accept the coaches proposal submitted by M State-Fergus Falls to permit up to 10 practice opportunities in the off-season.</li> <li>• Noted that a fall camp start date will need to be established based on the now-approved 2020 schedule.</li> </ul>	<p>MCAC Volleyball Coaches Meeting Minutes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Voted to accept the VB coaches proposals of: <b>Start Date: Aug. 5, '20);</b> <b>First Competition: Aug. 21, '20)</b> <b>Both Southern &amp; Northern Division</b> schedules as submitted.</li> <li>• Voted to accept all Division schedule change requests as submitted by member schools.</li> <li>• Voted against accepting the proposed schedule increase limit from 22 to 24 matches as originally passed by the VB coaches.</li> <li>• Noted that MCAC competition limits, including those in volleyball, will be on the agenda for the 2020 MCAC General Assembly on March 23-24.</li> </ul>
<p>MCAC M/W Basketball:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Voted to enact the standing committees in men's &amp; women's basketball to develop 2020-21 and 2021-22 M/W Divisional schedules. Committee oversight will be tasked to an EC member and Conference office.</li> <li>• Voted to table proposal from Ricci Media group for live-stream broadcast of the MCAC men's state tournament. This item will be discussed at the EC.</li> <li>• Noted that the Inter-Divisional (Crossover) schedule for the above-mentioned years is already completed.</li> </ul>	<p>Executive Committee Points of Emphasis &amp; Notes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• General Assembly agenda items should be submitted by member colleges no later than March 3<sup>rd</sup>.</li> <li>• Coaches, Athletic Administrators and upper Administration need to communicate, collaborate and confer on items which affect our campuses.</li> <li>• Schools should 'speak with one voice' and vote accordingly on items which affect membership and individual campuses.</li> <li>• A women's division committee to study post-season competition models has been established.</li> </ul>
