Hudl Presentation, Brett Shambin: Extensive proposal on part of Hudl, Inc. to become league-wide provider for athletic video services. Background on Hudl's presence in the MCAC currently (football), as well as services which could be provided in the future for conference schools. Dialog on pricing and product options.

MCAC Baseball update: as of EC meeting, 9 ejections have occurred in Region XIII baseball this season. Five of the 9 ejections have been coaches and/or staff. Concern exists among MCAC schools at conduct and image aspects in the sport of baseball. The conference office has traveled to multiple sites to watch contests- observed one ejection in which player was ejected for delaying contest.

Dugout control will be point of emphasis in post-season MCAC meetings.

MCAC Softball update: MCAC office noted need to formalize Northern Division season-ending tournament format and procedures.

Clay Target / Trapshooting: MCAC office noted interest on part of NHED schools and others in conducting fall trap league. Discussion on merits of club vs. varsity status. Dave Dailey noted need for synchronized scoring system to effectively conduct league. Steve C. noted that until the MCAC sponsors Clay Target as a sport, the conference office should be judicious with time devoted to this endeavor.
